

Birds that Don't Fly

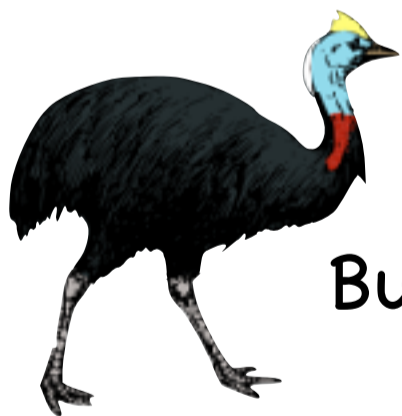
Some birds can't fly

but it won't do anything.

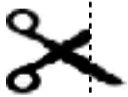


The Kakapo can't fly like it wants to.

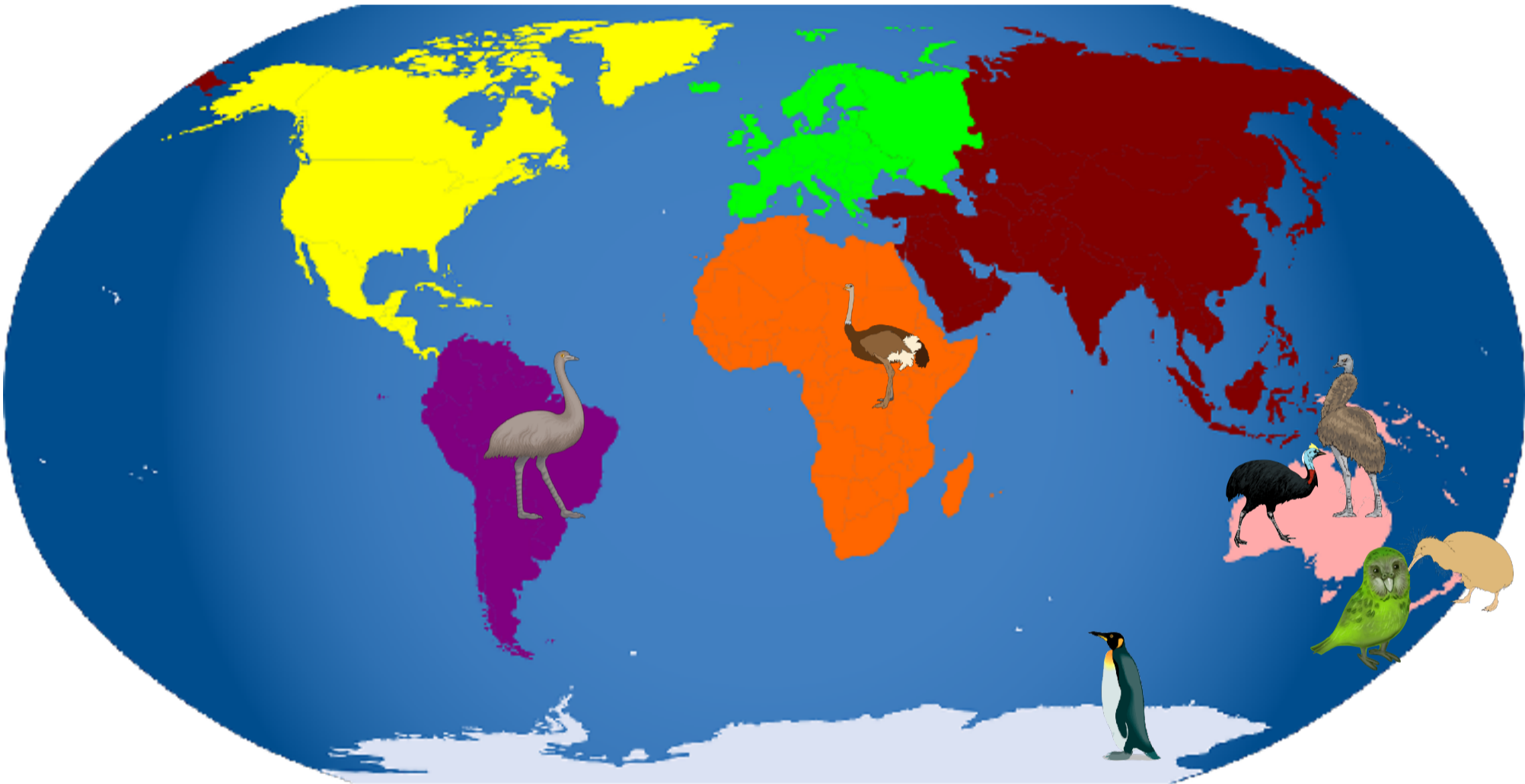
