

## Making the Suffix -ful Part 1

Suffixes are letters we add to the end of the word that change what the word means. The suffix -ful means full. Most of the time, you can just add the suffix to the end of the word. For example, pain is the root word. You can just add -ful to the end of the word pain to make painful.

Try it now. Turn the word pain into painful.

1. pain \_\_\_\_\_

To add a suffix to a root word, sometimes you need to change the word. For example, beauty is the root word. To add a suffix, you need to change the y into an i and then add the suffix -ful. This makes beautiful. Do this when the y is making a vowel sound.

Try it now. Turn the word beauty into beautiful.

2. beauty \_\_\_\_\_

If the y is not making a vowel sound such as with the word play, you can just add the suffix. So play would be playful.

Try it now. Turn the word play into playful.
