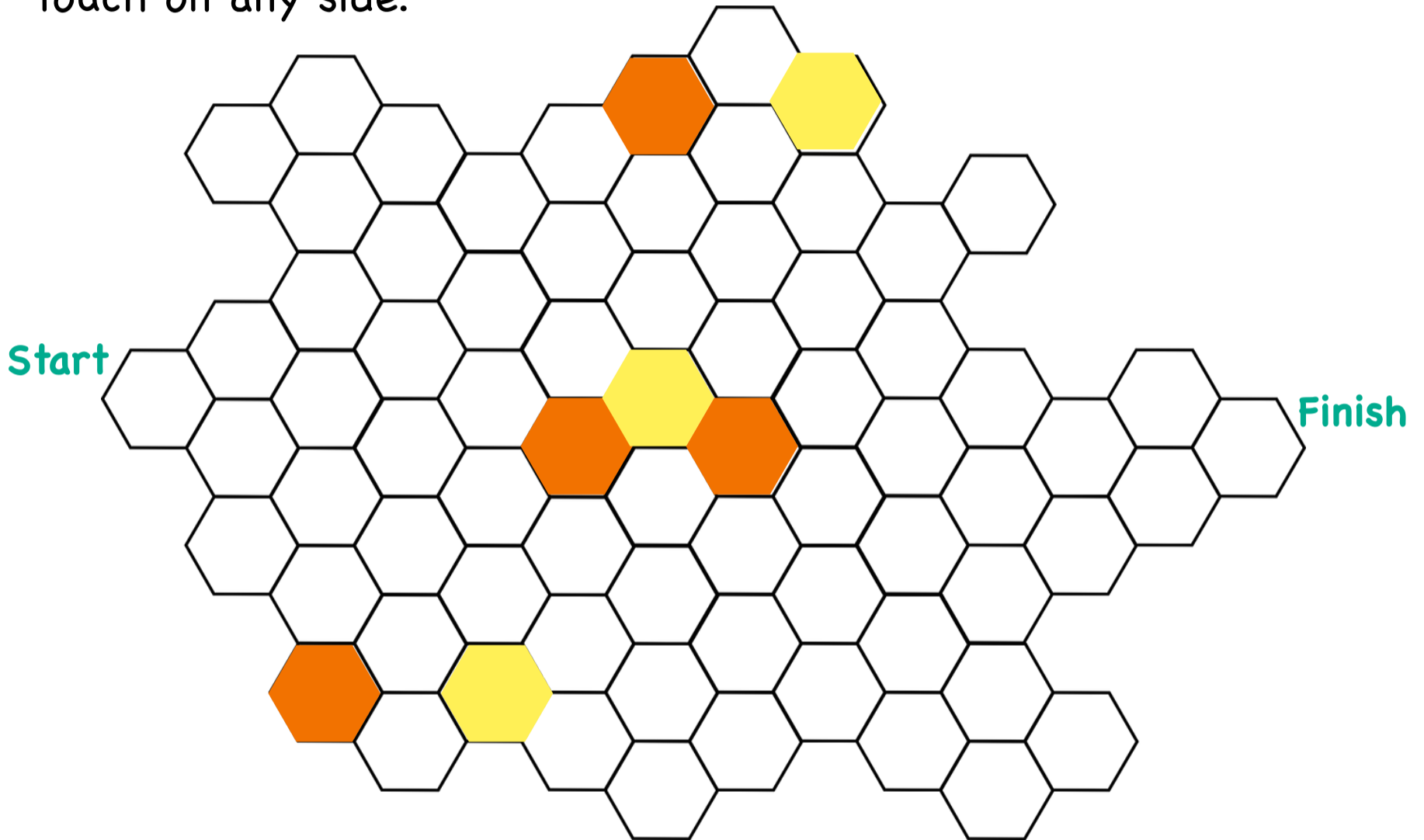


Honeycomb Maze

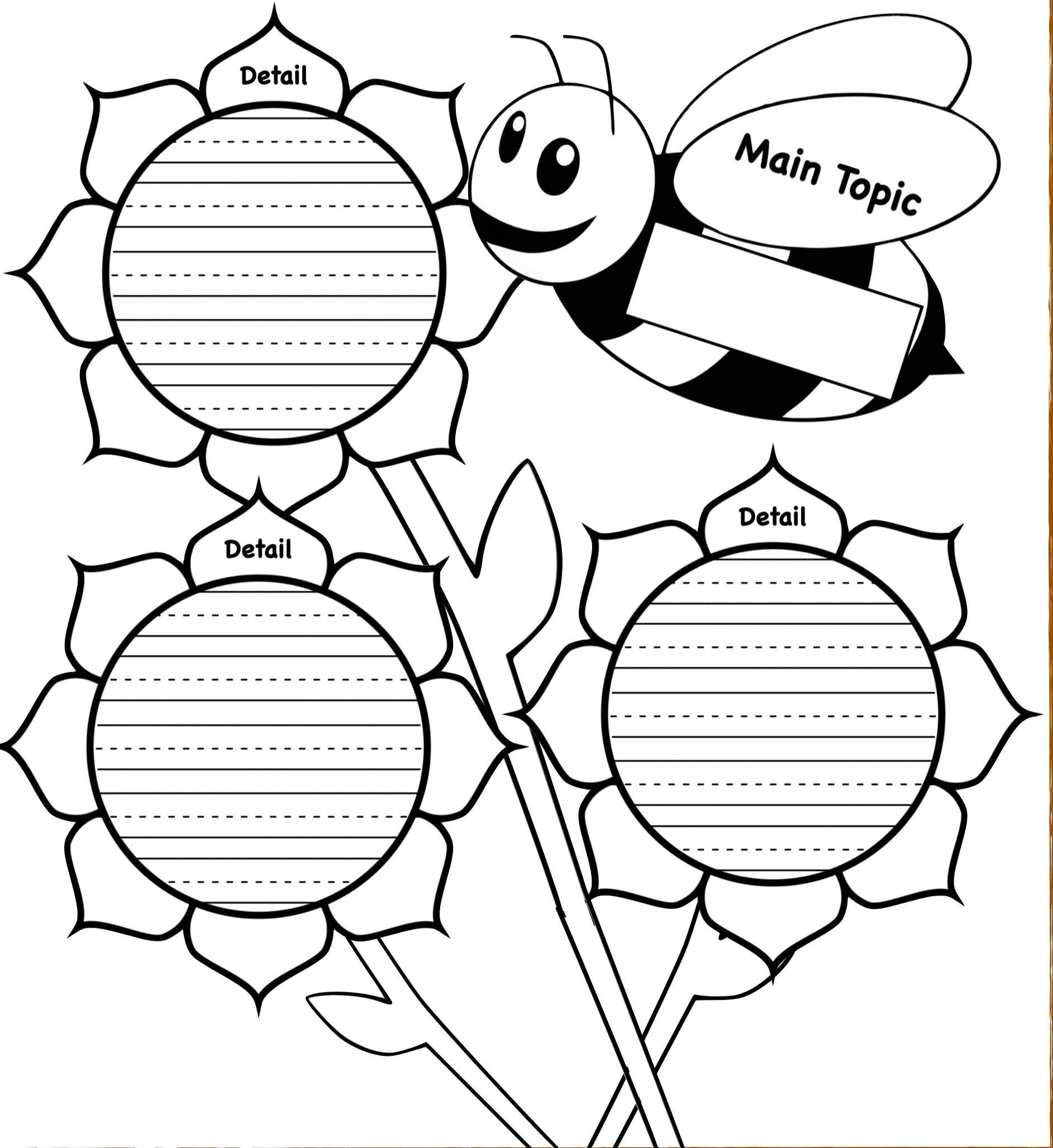

F. Photo of a bee larva.

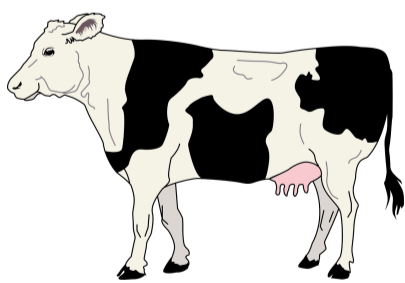
