

Finding the Suffix -ful

Suffixes are letters we add to the end of the word that change what word means. The suffix -ful means full. If you add it to the end of a word you can show that word is full of something. For example, helpful means giving a lot of help or beautiful means full of beauty. This also makes the word an adjective.
