

## Fiction Summary Part 1

Summarize means to tell what something is about in just a few words. To write a summary, you need to think about what the whole story was about. When writing a summary for a fiction story, you need to think about the main events that happened in the story. Sometimes you might also include the lesson the story taught you.

A fiction summary should include the <b>main character</b> . Who was this story mostly about?
In a story, there is usually something the main character <b>wants</b> . What does the dog in the story want?
In a story, there is a usually a <b>problem</b> that keeps the character from getting what they want right away. What was the dog's problem in the story?

	The story <b>ends</b> with the character either getting what they wanted, learning a lesson or in some other way no longer having the problem. How did this story end?

An easy sentence to remember when trying to summarize a fiction story is: The **character wanted** something **but** something kept them from it **so** they tried some things and **finally** there was an end to the story. [Character wanted but so finally] If you have all of those key parts, you will usually have a complete summary of the main events in a story.
